

## Eric P. Deliac, PhD

Dr Eric P. Déliac is President and Founder of Luy Resources.

Eric initially created Luy Resources to share his experience in business development, energy and raw materials, and technology management, prior to expanding the company's footprint with additional resources. His customers range from small high-tech companies and start-ups to large energy operators.

A mining and petroleum engineer by training, his experience in the energy domain covers more than three decades, together with deep experience of developing business in high technology sectors.

Eric is passionate about the energy transition and the fast development of alternative energy resources for a sustainable future.

Examples of his recent projects include being a strategic advisor to design a decommissioning plan for an offshore asset in Ghana, designing and developing a new smart EV charging station optimizing energy allocation using solar panels and battery storage, a study of skilled resource needs for the international energy production industry, and a detailed market analysis for fast growing subsurface energy resources, such as deep geothermal, geothermal lithium, native hydrogen or helium.

Prior to his current position, Eric oversaw the international business development of Oxand, a fast-growing strategic consulting company specialized in risk-based asset management for the global energy industry.

Before this, Eric established Petris Technology operations in the Eastern Hemisphere, growing the company consistently for 10 years. Focused on oil & gas information management, it was sold to Halliburton in 2012. Eric then became Director of Strategic Business Development, Europe & Sub-Sahara Africa at Halliburton, responsible for expanding the reach of Landmark's software and services to the Europe and Sub-Sahara Africa region.

Prior to joining Petris, Eric had been president and chief operating officer of GeoNet Services, the first Application Service Provider in the Oil & Gas industry. From 1997 to 2000, Eric was Executive Vice President of CGG, a Geophysical service provider, where he successfully introduced an integrated Geoscience and Reservoir division which, to date, is still one of the most successful business lines of the company. In 1993 he was vice president of research and development for Elf Exploration and Production with a worldwide responsibility. In this position, he was instrumental in developing the company's technology in various areas like deep and ultra-deep offshore E&P, which led to the successful development of major discoveries in West Africa.

Before joining the energy industry, Eric worked for the French Government civil service for 8 years, during which he developed and then headed the Underground Resource Engineering Department of the Paris School of Mines. He directed 15 doctorate theses and published a number of technical papers. In this position he also advised multiple mining companies in Europe and in Africa.

Eric graduated from Ecole Polytechnique (Paris) and the Paris School of Mines. Eric later earned an additional Master's degree in Mineral Processing and a Doctorate in Rock Physics from the Paris University. He has been a member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers since 1989 and currently holds a lifetime membership.

Eric is a member of the International Association of Energy Economists (IAEE) and of the French Société de l'Industrie Minérale (SIM).

Eric speaks French (native), English (fluent) and Portuguese (basic). He is a citizen of France and of the USA.
